Baptism Preparation Classes

Parents and godparents must attend baptism preparation class prior to a child's baptism. At least one godparent must be a confirmed Catholic and lead a life in harmony with the Catholic faith by providing proof of Confirmation and, if applicable, marriage in the Catholic Church. 


The Lord Works in Mysterious Ways








Knights of Columbus Supports People with Intellectual Disabilities This Weekend
















Prayer for All Saints Day






